NIGHT OR DAY

For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the Lord. **13** And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye are: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you, when I smite the land of Egypt. **14** And this day shall be unto you for a memorial; and ye shall keep it a feast to the Lord throughout your generations; ye shall keep it a feast by an ordinance for ever. Exodus 12: 12-14

God had said to Pharaoh through Moses, "Let my people go." But Pharaoh refused to let them go. So God sends a series of plagues on Egypt. But Pharaoh still refused to let the people go. Then in Exodus 12, we are told that God sent the most severe of the plagues, the death of the firstborn.

In this passage there are two words that describe the condition of every person in the world today. You are either living in the night or in the day.

This Night - this describes every person who is lost. They are living in the darkness of the night. If you are lost, you are in the darkness of sin, darkness of judgement, darkness of death, darkness of condemnation, and in the darkness of hell.

This Day - this describes every person who is saved. They are living in the light of the day. If you are saved, you are in the light of life, light of peace, light of purpose, light of direction, and the ultimate light of heaven.

What determines whether a person is living in the night or in the day? Well, thank God, in verse 12, the key is the blood. God said, "When I see the blood I will pass over you." It was a great day in my life when I left the night and came into the light. The thing that made that possible was when I trusted the precious blood of the Lamb of God, the Lord Jesus Christ for my salvation!

Where are you in your life? In the night or in the light? It is what you do with the blood. Thank God for the blood that takes us from the night to the day,

This is the message that I preach week after week, salvation through the blood of Jesus Christ.
