Harvest is Passing Away

As I look out the window of my house, I am reminded that summer is coming to an end. Across the road they have already harvested the soybeans. Harvest has come to a close. This is what the prophet Jeremiah was talking about in Jeremiah 8:20. "The harvest is past, the summer is ended, and we are not saved." Let me give you the background of this passage. Jeremiah had preached to the people of Jerusalem. He had warned them that they must repent of their sins and that only God could deliver them. But they had the idea that the armies of Egypt would come down to protect them from the armies of Babylon. They put their trust in man rather than to trust God.

Remember that the people lived in a walled city. Then the armies of Babylon surrounded the city and cut them off from their food supply. Summer had come to an end and their crops planted all around the city begin to fall to the ground. The Babylonians got what they wanted to eat. But inside the city there was no food and Jeremiah knew that the people had crossed God's deadline. He lifted up his voice and he cried out, "The harvest is past, the summer is ended, and we are not saved." Starvation engulfed the city. It was terrible!! It was horrible!! Let me give you some harvest times that are passing away today:

Number One: Harvest Time is Passing Away for Our Society.

On July 4, 1776, the United States of America was born. God gave America a Lord, Himself. God gave America a law, the Constitution, which was based on the Word of God. But in spite of our great foundation, we are being over whelmed with crime, murderers, gambling, thievery, and sexual immorality!!
