My passion and heart's desire is to see people come to Christ and be saved. I love to preach to large crowds and see people respond to a public invitation. Three weeks later I was preaching another revival in Beaumont, Texas. That pastor came to the service one night and I asked him how Mercedes was doing. I could tell he was embarrassed because he had not done the follow up. I came home on Thursday.

As Paul Harvey used to say, "Now The Rest Of The Story." On Friday night that pastor called me. He said, "Don, I need to ask you to forgive me. I forgot to do follow up with Mercedes. But this morning I went to the hotel where she where she worked. I asked the clerk at the front desk if there was a Mercedes that worked there. She said, 'Are you talking about that Mercedes that found Jesus?' He said, 'Yes.' She said, 'Everybody in this hotel knows that Mercedes found Jesus.' She said, 'We don't know what that man did to her in that room. We don't know if he baptized her or what. But, when she came out of that room everybody knew that Mercedes had found Jesus. All she wants to talk about is Jesus." Mercedes is that fruit that remains.

Let me encourage you to go find you a Mercedes and tell her about Jesus!!
