ON THE JERICHO ROAD

In Luke 10: 25-37 we are given the parable of the Good Samaritan . You remember a parable is an earthly story with a heavenly meaning. God not only inspired the Bible, but God also illustrates great Biblical truths. The parable of the Good Samaritan is one of the best known in all the Bible. You remember all the Bible is about Jesus. The Bible says in John 5:39, "Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me." The man who fell among thieves is a picture of sinners in need of a Savior. The Good Samaritan is a picture of Jesus who came to where we are to save us. He took him to the inn and told the inn keeper to take care of him "until I come again."

Do you know what that inn is? That is the church. Do you know who that inn keeper is? That is you and me. Here is a person who is lost, naked, beaten and hurting. Jesus comes to him in grace. He forgives him. He saves him. He takes him to an inn. He says the man needs help. He is not through healing yet, he is not through the shock of being beaten up yet. Will you take care of him? Will you continue what I started? I I started his deliverance, you continue his deliverance. Jesus says, what I started, I want you to continue.

God sends people that He rescued and we need to care for them. If you and your church will not take care of them, God will take them on down the road to a church who will take care of them.

Last month I was teaching a mid day service in a church just outside of Houston, Texas on this passage. When I got to this point in the message, there was a woman who walked in the side door of the gym where we were. She was a homeless woman. She had on cowboy boots, shorts, dirty shirt and a cowboy hat. I heard the pastor say, "I just helped her yesterday, I wonder what she wants today." To my surprise she started talking out loud, I stopped preaching. She said, "I just wanted to come by today and say Thank you for helping me yesterday. May God bless you!" Then she left! I thought what an illustration of what I was trying to preach about.
